- The fund is meant to cover costs to improve the research idea and to bring the PI up to the ERC project proposal submission at EU level;
- It is possible to dedicate up to 25.000,00 euros of the total budget to the contract renewal of the PI, only in case the contract with Unicam ends before the end of the project's activities;
- The max. of the budget is 75.000,00 euros
